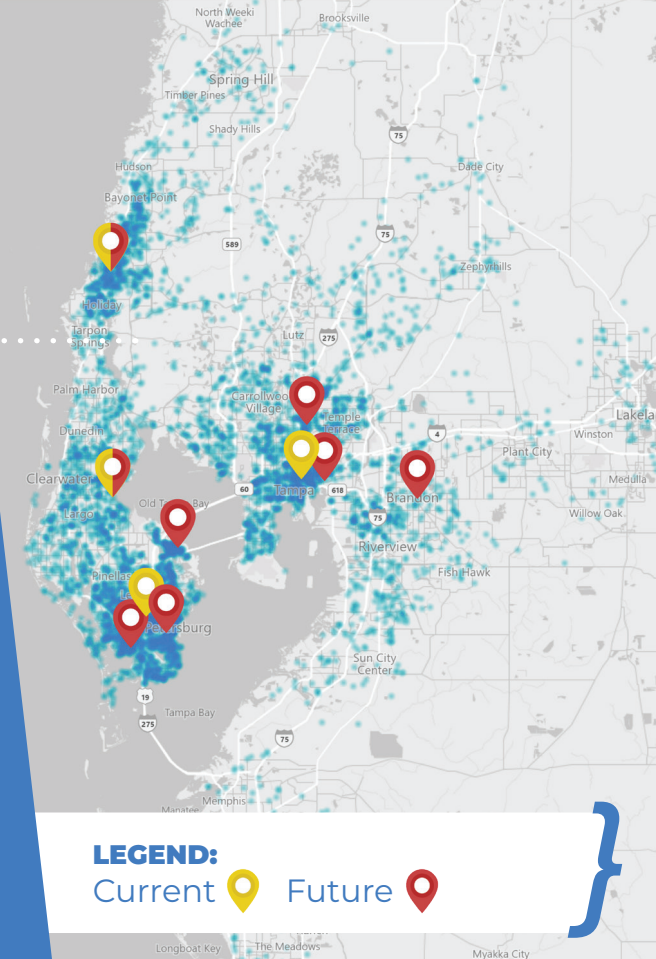

Prevention & Sexual Health

PrEP or Pre-exposure prophylaxis is a daily pill that can prevent HIV. PrEP in 30 provided dozens with access to daily HIV prevention in 30 minutes or less.

Food Security

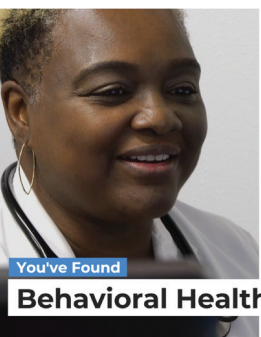
Health starts with basic nutrition. In addition to medical services, we provide free meals to clients with demonstrated need.
